



What will you learn in



Participants

The total number of students who take part in this summer school are 40 students. Therefore, there will be around 5 until 8 students to form a team.

Each team will create 2 videos in the workshop using the Go Pro Fusion 360 degree camera that will be provided. The students have to bring their laptop and smartphone. The output will be a 360 video that can be uploaded to Youtube, so the video can be viewed using smartphone with or without VR Box/ headset.

Facilitation

One facilitator from Graduate program will be in charge to take care the students for each team. To support the activities, we will provide translators for each country during the program which will be fully conducted in English.

Hardware and Software

We expect every participants equipped with basic skill in any design software such as Adobe Suite (Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop, Premiere, After Effect, etc) or development software such as Unity, Unreal Engine, HTML, etc. specification of devices.

To support the program, at least any laptop with RAM 4GB and Processor i5 is required. For smartphone, gyroscope and accelerator sensors is a must. But higher specification for the devices is better for production process.
